Thoughts from our Guidance Counselor:

In September, I will be meeting with classes to discuss what bullying is and how the students can help themselves when being bullied. Bullying is unwanted, aggressive behavior among school aged children that involves a real perceived power imbalance. The behavior is repeated, or has the potential to be repeated, over time.

Types of Bullying

-**Verbal Bullying** is saying or writing mean things.

-**Cyber Bullying** includes spreading rumors about someone, telling others not to intentionally include someone else using technology as the means to spread the message.

-**Physical Bullying** involves hurting a person or someone's possessions.

Important Announcements:
