Student Medication Procedures and Protocols

- 1. All medications must be in the original container. A parent must bring in the medication to the nurse's office. There are exceptions, for example: inhalers, but please check with the nurse before sending it in with your child.
- 2. It is required that 2 forms be filled out for the nurse to administer medications to your child. One is a parent permission form which is required to be filled out before giving medication, and a physician permission form that can be taken with you, dropped off at your child's doctors office, and then faxed to me from there. My fax number is listed on the top right of the form.
- 3. When a students medication needs a refill or is expired, the nurse will contact the parent to renew and refill the prescription.
- 4. During registration you are asked to give the nurse permission to give your child OTC (over the counter) medications. Tylenol, cough drops, Calcium Carbonate, Hydrocortisone cream, Calamine Lotion, Antibiotic ointment are available. Children's Benadryl is also available but will not be given until given permission by a parent first.
